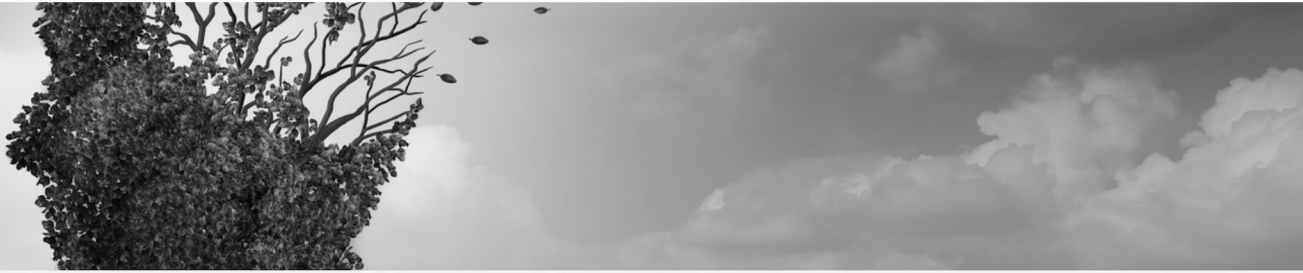




# CERTIFICATE IN UNDERSTANDING THE PRINCIPLES OF DEMENTIA CARE
