At the end of the apprenticeship program, learners must complete their End Point Assessment (EPA). This is completed by an external provider (TQUK).

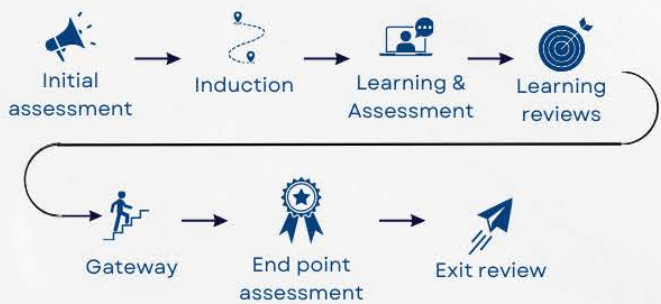
